LEADERSHIP GIVE BACK PROJECT

The USASF Leadership Give Back Project is available to All Star Athletes who have completed the USASF BOLT/MARCH Leadership training. The project is offered so that athletes may implement a project utilizing the leadership skills they have developed while at BOLT/MARCH.

Contributors to the Give Back Project must complete a submission form stating their intent to participate by October 15, 2021 and will have until December 31, 2021 to complete their project.

Participants in the Give Back Project will be offered support and mentoring from the Alumni of the Athlete Advisory Council. Each participant must document their project and provide the USASF with documentation from either program owners, coaches or teachers substantiating their efforts.

Complete the Give Back submission form by October 15, 2021. This is only available by invitation from USASF Leadership Director Karen Wilson.

2

Attend the scheduled virtual mentoring sessions offered by invitation only.

Choose your project from one of the following:

- Healthy Kids Out of School — Projects based on health and nutrition.
- Put yourself in my place — Projects designed to teach sensitivity for typical athletes who interact with exceptional athletes.
- Choose a Community Service Project from the USASF Season of Service page located at www.usasf.net/this-is-all-star.

Choose your platform for a leadership project, will it be within your program, at your school, or in your community?

5

Identify an adult from the program, school or community to oversee your efforts and be available to substantiate your results.

6

Set your dates for implementation and complete the project.

7

Record your efforts.

8

You will receive a link in January to submit the following:

1. Letter from your adult advisor substantiating your project
2. A one-minute video demonstrating your efforts
3. A one-page essay on the impact your give back project had for you and your students.

Benefits

The USASF Leadership team will review all submissions and select up to ten give back projects. Those selected will be offered the following opportunities:

- Advanced Leadership Training specializing in interviews, public speaking and presentations.
- The opportunity to present the results of the Give Back Project to the USASF Regional Advisory Board Council in Spring 2021.
