HEALTH AND SAFETY

What will The Cheerleading Worlds and The Dance Worlds be like with regards to COVID-19 safety?

Together, with the Walt Disney World Resort, we've made many updates to the championship experience. Before you register, it is imperative that you read everything carefully and make sure you share this information with your athletes and parents. Are face coverings required?

Guests who are not fully vaccinated will be expected to continue wearing face coverings indoors. This includes upon entering and throughout all indoor venues, attractions, registration tents and indoor queues. Face coverings will continue to be required for all Guests on enclosed Disney transportation, regardless of vaccination status. A mask is expected to be worn at all times inside venues for non-vaccinated athletes except when on the warm up floor and performance floor. 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What is a Safety Champion?

Each team must designate one Safety Champion who is over the age of 18 and not the coach. Coaches will need to enter this information on their registration. The Safety Champion must be willing to participate in additional safety training from the Walt Disney World Resort prior to the competition. Programs bringing multiple teams are required to have a different Safety Champion for each team. Safety Champions do not receive any special access to the competition. The Safety Champion's responsibilities include, but are not limited to: ensuring the athletes, coaches and spectators of your team follow the health and safety requirements such as face coverings. More information about the training will be sent out prior to the championship.

Can a coach be with the Safety Champions when they receive their extra training, so the coach knows exactly what the Safety Champions need to do?

Yes! The coach has the option to go through the training with the team's Safety Champion. However, the coach cannot serve as the Safety Champion. More information about the training will be sent out prior to Worlds.

Will you have spectators in the competition venues and for awards?

At this time, there are no capacity limits in the Worlds venues. Spectators will be allowed for awards ceremonies.

Do we have to get a negative COVID-19 test prior to arriving in Orlando or before we compete?

Will we have temperature checks?

At this time, there will be no temperature checks this year at Worlds.

Are there any travel restrictions into Florida?

Before traveling to Florida, please make sure that you have reviewed advisories or restrictions that may be in place for travel to Florida. Guests who are under isolation or quarantine orders should not travel to the event and must not enter Walt Disney World Resort.

SPECTATOR TICKETS

What is the spectator viewing process this year?

Disney has no restrictions on venue capacity this year. Coaches who are registering parents on their hotel travel package, or parents registering on their own, will be asked which performances they are coming to watch. We do not anticipate going back to limited spectators, however we are asking this information just in case we have to go back to limiting spectators.

Do spectators have to purchase a Worlds Park Hopper® to watch The Cheerleading Worlds and The Dance Worlds competitions?

No. Family and friends who DO NOT purchase Worlds hotel packages or Park Hopper tickets may enter the competition venues with daily competition admission tickets or wristbands as described below.

THE CHEERLEADING WORLDS

\$45 daily ticket

These may be purchased online prior to arriving in Orlando and will be available for purchase at the ESPN Wide World of Sport Complex the day of the event. Online sales begin a few weeks prior to the event. Please watch for more details.

THE DANCE WORLDS

\$40 daily wristband | \$100 three-day wristband

Worlds Park Hopper tickets must be pre-ordered. No Worlds Park Hopper® tickets will be sold in Orlando.

PARK HOPPER® PASS TICKETS

What does Walt Disney World® Resort Park Hopper® Pass mean?

A Walt Disney World® Resort Park Hopper® Pass ticket allows guests to visit more than one park per day for each day of the ticket.

- Guests must make a theme park reservation via the Disney park pass reservation system for the first park they plan to visit. After entering that first park, guests will be able to visit the next park starting at 2 pm until each park's regularly scheduled closure.
- The ability to visit a park is subject to the park's capacity limitations.
- At this time a park reservation is not required after the first park, however, reservation requirements are subject to change.

When will we receive our Park Hopper® Pass tickets?

Once your registration is complete and fully paid, your ticket confirmation numbers will be ordered through Disney. Approximately 7-10 business days later, a ticket confirmation number will be emailed to you.

- **No changes will be accepted after ticket orders have been placed, including upgrades.**
- You must make a theme park reservation for each day that you plan to visit a theme park.
- It's possible that parks may reach capacity so we strongly suggest you register and pay early so you can get your tickets and make your reservation for your top theme park choices.

If we do not use all the days on our Park Hopper® Pass tickets, may we use them next year?

No. Worlds Park Hoppers are valid April 13-27, 2022. No refunds will be given for unused portions of tickets.

May I buy extra Worlds Park Hopper tickets on-site in Orlando?

No. All Worlds Park Hoppers must be preordered online through Worlds registration site. Extra tickets cannot be added the athlete/coach registration. You must place a separate ticket order. We will not be selling any Worlds Park Hoppers on site in Orlando.

Are Worlds Park Hopper tickets available for family and friends not on the travel package?

Yes. We offer three different tickets: 3-day, 4-day and 5-day. Please see [EXTRA TICKET PRICING](#).

- A Worlds Park Hopper ticket is valid for admission into the Magic Kingdom® Park, Epcot®, Disney's Hollywood Studios®, and Disney's Animal Kingdom® theme parks as well as admission into the ESPN Wide World of Sports® Complex.
- You will need to make a park reservation to enter the first theme park you plan to visit each day. After entering that first park, you may hop to a different park after 2 pm without a reservation.
- It's possible that parks may reach capacity so we strongly suggest you register and pay early so you can get your tickets and book your park reservation.
- Worlds Park Hopper tickets must be pre-ordered and will not be sold on site.
- Friends and Family will need the team customer number to order Worlds Park Hopper tickets. Please ask your coach or gym owner for this team number.
- **NOTE:** Worlds Park Hopper tickets DO NOT include bus transportation to and from the competitions. Only those with Worlds hotel package lanyards may use the competition shuttles.

Will we get physical tickets this year?

No. All tickets will be digital, and you must use Disney MagicMobile to access the park. Once you pay in full you will receive your ticket confirmation numbers from Worlds Registration. You also will receive information on how to link these ticket numbers to a My Disney Experience account and how to create a Disney MagicMobile pass. Once you are at the theme park, your tickets will be available by holding up your eligible smart device near an access point to enter the park.

How do I link my Park Hopper ticket confirmation number?

You will receive instructions on how to link your ticket confirmation number to your My Disney Experience account so that you can make your park reservations. Please link your tickets and make your park reservations as soon as you can as parks can fill up.

If we add an extra day to their hotel package, are we able to use our Worlds Park Hopper ticket to go to theme parks on those days?

Yes! Worlds Park Hopper tickets are valid April 13-27, 2022. You may visit the parks during those dates as long as you have a park reservation. Remember that adding an additional hotel night to your package does not automatically add another night to your theme park ticket and vice versa. Each must be added separately.

If I purchase additional Worlds Park Hopper tickets, where can I pick them up in Orlando?

Those who purchase Worlds Park Hopper tickets will receive their ticket confirmation numbers via email once they are paid in full. You also will receive instructions on how to link them to a My Disney Experience account and create a Disney MagicMobile pass. Physical ticket media cards will not be distributed, so you will not need to check in at the Worlds registration desk in Orlando.

How can I add Disney Genie, Genie+ or Lightning Lane to our Worlds Park Hopper ticket?

- Guests who have valid theme park admission and a Disney Park Pass reservation linked to their My Disney Experience account who are 18 or over, are able to purchase the Disney Genie+ service on the day of their theme park visit and may choose to purchase individual à la carte Lightning Lane selections* at the published park opening, using the My Disney Experience mobile app.
- Please note, park reservations are limited in number and subject to availability. Attractions with Lightning Lane entrances that are included with Disney Genie+ service and individual purchases are limited in availability, subject to change or closure, may vary by date, and are not guaranteed. - **PLEASE NOTE:** Do not pay in full until you know all your changes and ticket upgrades have been processed. Once you pay in full, your ticket order goes in a queue to be processed. Tickets cannot be changed or upgraded after the order has been placed.

COMPETITION SCHEDULES

How do I find out when and where my team competes?

A detailed order of competition will be posted on TheCheerleadingWorlds.net and TheDanceWorlds.net closer to the event. The detailed order of competition will tell you the location and exact times that your team will report to warmup and compete.

How will we know what days to schedule for the park if we don't have a time frame for the competition?

USASF/IASF will post block schedules for Worlds as soon as they are available. We suggest that you book park reservations for the number of days on your theme park ticket.

Will cheer teams able to practice in open areas around the resort or at ESPN Wide World of Sports?

Yes. Cheer teams will be able to practice in open areas around the resorts on safe surfaces. ESPN Wide World of Sports will have a designated outdoor practice area for teams. Outdoor practice will be allowed only in this designated area.

When will practice times be released?

The Cheerleading Worlds only: The order of competition will be released a few weeks prior to Worlds. It will indicate the following for each team: an outdoor practice time (about one hour before performance); an indoor warm-up time; and a performance time. Each team will go directly from their outdoor practice to the venue to check in for warmups prior to performance.

HOTEL TRAVEL PACKAGE

What is the difference between the Disney All Star Resort and Coronado Springs Resort?

The main difference in package prices is the hotel cost only. All services remain the same for both hotels. The All Star Resort accommodations are very nice yet economical. Accommodations at the Coronado Springs Resort are more upscale.

We have parents who would like to come to Worlds. Can they purchase the hotel travel package?

Of course! Many coaches meet with the parents and include them on the travel package with their teams. However, we encourage family members and friends to register with us directly. Parents will need the team's unique registration ID number that coach receives after the team registers and is approved.

How do parents register for the hotel travel package themselves?

Once the coach registers and the registration has been approved, they will receive a unique registration ID number (usually within 48 business hours of registering). Parents should obtain this registration ID from the coach, then:

- go to the [WORLDS REGISTRATION](#) page,
- click the [REGISTRATION](#) tab,
- click [FAMILY/INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION](#) and follow the instructions.

Will all of our rooms be housed together? Can we request for adjoining rooms or a specific location?

Special requests may be made but are not guaranteed. Please note that not all rooms are adjoining so your party may be split.

Can we get our room confirmation numbers?

Unfortunately we cannot provide individual hotel room reservation numbers and confirmation numbers because the hotels are booked as a group for the entire event.

Is transportation to and from the airport included in the hotel travel package?

No. Transportation between the airport and Disney resort is not included in the travel package as Disney's Magical Express is no longer operating. Please visit the ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT website for information about transportation options.

Is transportation from the Worlds hotels to the competition venues included in the hotel travel package?

Yes. Those on the hotel travel package will receive a lanyard that grants access to the transportation.

We have an uneven number of athletes. Can we pay the quad rate for three athletes in a room?

No. The travel package prices have been calculated according to how many people are in each room.

Can we have five people in a room?

No. The resorts do not allow more than four people to a room.

When will our hotel rooms be ready for check-in?

Hotels do not guarantee check in until 4 pm. However, if there are rooms ready in your block, the hotel may check you in early. Please be sure to communicate this to your entire group that is traveling with you.

Where will commuter athletes register once they arrive in Orlando?

Commuter athletes do NOT need to individually register at the Worlds registration desk in Orlando. Commuters will receive their Worlds Park Hopper confirmation numbers via email once paid in full. Coaches will collect commuter lanyards for the team when they check in.

Our flight isn't until 6 pm on our departure day. What can we do all day?

Hotel check out is at 11 am. If you wish, the hotel will store your luggage while you shop or play but you will be responsible for collecting them before you depart.

Can I purchase a Disney meal plan?

No. Disney meal plans cannot be added to our package.

Is there a Celebration Party or extended park hours this season?

Yes! We are excited to bring back the extended park hours on Friday night as well as the Celebration Party on Monday night! **These are included for those on the hotel travel package.**

- For the extended park hours, guests will need to either make a reservation for Hollywood Studios for that day or have another park reservation for that day and hop to Hollywood Studios that evening.
- Entering Hollywood Studios for extended park hours will use one day on your Worlds Park Hopper.
- Those attending the Celebration Party, do not need a theme park reservation to Magic Kingdom on their ticket for that event.
- Commuters may purchase tickets for the Celebration party.

If athletes register as commuters, can they use the Worlds competition shuttle to and from the competition venues?

No. Transportation is only provided for those purchasing the hotel travel package.

Do families need to pay for a child that is 2 or under?

For example, a family of five includes a 2-year-old child.

No. Children under 3 do not need a ticket to enter the theme parks or competitions.

What is the registration deadline?

REMINDER: A park reservation is required to visit a theme park. The later you register and make final payment, the greater the risk of not being able to make a reservation at the theme park of your choice.

CHANGES, REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

How long does it take to process a change on my registration?

Please allow 48 hours from submission for changes to be processed.

How do I request a refund?

- Refunds must be requested in writing no later than 30 days after the event is over.
- Refund requests may be emailed to your registration specialist.
- Refunds will be issued after the event is over.
- The average processing time for a refund is four weeks from the date the request is received.
- Refunds are not issued unless a written request is received.
- No refunds will be given for unused portion of park tickets.

What is the cancellation policy for the event?

What will happen if our team must cancel due to a positive COVID-19 test prior to arrival in Orlando? Will we get a refund?

If an entire team has to cancel due to COVID-19 prior to arrival in Orlando, a letter from the program owner or parent (family group) indicating the reason for the cancellation is necessary for a full refund of fees paid to USASF/IASF. Individual cancellations must follow the cancellation policy included in the *Registration Information & Competition Guidelines* as linked below. We cannot refund any unused portion of the hotel travel package or tickets.

Do refunds go directly back to parents?

Refunds are issued back to the person who paid USASF/IASF for the registration. For example, if the payment to USASF/IASF was made via the gym credit card, it will be returned to the gym.

Where should I turn in athlete/coach waivers?

All athletes and coaches must complete release waiver forms. Coaches will turn in these waivers with all required event forms during Worlds registration in Orlando. Spectators are not required to turn in a release waiver.
